Notes in relation to the application process

Application Process:

There are two stages in the application process for a place on the Pastoral Liturgy programme

Stage 1:

Application form

Applicants must complete the application form and return it to the Admissions Office, Pontifical University, St Patrick's College, Maynooth, Co. Kildare, Ireland and the National Centre for Liturgy, St Patrick's College, Maynooth, Co. Kildare, Ireland.

In order for stage 1 of the application process to be complete, a letter of Recommendation must be sent <u>directly</u> from an academic referee, a local parish priest and a pastoral ministry referee (as relevant) to the Admissions Office. An official statement of academic studies completed and grades obtained must be sent <u>directly</u> from the relevant institution(s) to the Admissions Office.

Stage 2:

Interview

All applicants are interviewed by members of the National Centre for Liturgy and Faculty. Applicants who are successful at the interview stage of the application process will be notified.

Where an applicant has to wait for primary degree results an offer may be made pending these results.
